## NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

### Rules Applying to Dog Shows

Effective January 1, 2010

#### CHAPTER 11, SECTION 1.

No dog shall be exhibited in a licensed or member dog show, except for dogs entered in the Miscellaneous Class unless it is either individually registered in the AKC Stud Book, or individually registered with a foreign registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration.

See <http://www.akc.org/pdfs/rulebooks/RREGS3.pdf> for complete detail of the rule change.

### ATTENTION EXHIBITORS

The Show Site will be available to exhibitors no earlier than 1:00 pm Friday, September 11, 2009. Dogs must be removed from the show site immediately following Best in Show judging on September 13, 2009.

No admission charge, with paid entry.

All vehicles camping overnight at the show site will have to pay an overnight camping fee. Overnight vehicle camping only in designated areas.

Please note that due to Health Department regulations, the designated Overnight Camping is at the north end of the Fairgrounds. See Camping Form on page 6.

Grooming building will be locked on Friday, September 11, 2009 and Saturday, September 12, 2009 from 10:00 pm until 6:00 am the following morning.

Grooming building must be vacated immediately following Best in Show judging on September 13, 2009. Please clean up after yourself. Grounds must be cleaned.

No vehicles permitted in the grooming building.

All buildings are smoke free.

Food will be available at the show site.

**No general crating or grooming in the Graham Arena (One).**

**Dogs may not be left overnight in the building.**

No exercise pens inside the building. Exercise pens outside in designated areas only.

Dogs must not be left unattended in Hotel/Motel rooms. Dogs must not be bathed in Hotel/Motel rooms. Violations will be subject to the show committee hearing.

Exhibitors are responsible for clean up.

City ordinance requires **immediate** removal of all dog waste. This will be enforced by the City. Violators subject to fine by the city and show committee hearing.

Roping off of unused crating & grooming space is prohibited. No mats in the grooming area. Crates must be stacked if possible. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their area clean and disposing of all waste before leaving the show site.

Exhibitors will exercise control over their children while on the show premise. At all times the welfare and behavior of the exhibitor's children will be the responsibility of the exhibitor.

City ordinance requires all dogs to be on leash in all public buildings and on all public grounds, except when crated or doing off-leash exercises in the show ring. Violators subject to city fine and show committee hearing.

Help foster the sport of pure-bred dogs. All behavior of exhibitors and dogs is expected to be sportsmanlike and abiding by all laws and rules.

**The Star of the North Chinese Shar-Pei Club & the Rochester Minnesota Kennel Club, Inc. do not agree to arbitrate claims as set forth on the Official AKC entry form for these events.**

At the discretion of the judge, the following breeds may be judged on a ramp: Clumber Spaniels, Sussex Spaniels, Basset Hounds, Whippets, Irish Terriers, Kerry Blue Terriers, Soft Coated Wheaten Terriers, Staffordshire Bull Terriers, Bulldogs, Chinese Shar-Pei, Chow Chows, Keeshonden & Polish Lowland Sheepdogs. Ramps may be used in emergency situations to judge any breed. (In an emergency situation, an exhibitor does have the option of withdrawing their entry and receiving a refund)

**NEW EXHIBITOR BRIEFING** on Saturday. Check Judging Program for time & location.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents for each dog and an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each recordable single entry class at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2). A \$3.00 AKC Recording Fee will be required for each entry in Rally. (American Kennel Club Rally Regulation, Chapter 1, Section 3) These Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS MUST SUBMIT ENTRIES WITH CHECKS DRAWN ON U.S. ACCOUNTS OR WITH INTERNATIONAL MONEY ORDERS IN U.S. FUNDS.**

There will be no refund for duplicate entries.

Dogs need be present only for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging.

Dogs allowed in rings during judging only.

Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the club nor its Superintendents will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying exhibitors or their agents of Breed or Class Judging. Judges need not wait for any dog holding up a class. **Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging rings.**

The Club reserves the right to substitute a prize of equal or greater value.

All trophies must be claimed the day of the show - None will be mailed.

All checks issued as prizes are the sole responsibility of the recipient. Lost, stolen and/or misplaced checks will not be replaced. Checks are valid for 90 days. The Superintendent is not able to cash checks.

**RETURNED CHECKS/INVALID CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. Fees must be paid in guaranteed funds. Checks will not be accepted. The Superintendent will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check & credit/debit card. Subsequent returned checks & credit/debit card from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Entry Fee will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or judge or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

No entry fees will be refunded if the Show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or the Superintendent.

The show giving Club, the Show Superintendent, their agents, employees, etc, assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees, signatures or the "Agreement" on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form.

Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Those received by telephone are not acceptable.

Refunds of \$3.00 & less will not be issued due to the costs of processing.

An administrative fee of \$2.00 will be charged for all cancellations or changes made prior to closing of entries.

**EXHIBITORS NOTE:** Please notify Superintendent of any change of address.

All entries received with credit/debit card for payment will have a service charge added.

### OPTION 1: Overnight RV Parking by Reservations Only 1 block from show building

Fifteen RV parking spaces on fairgrounds with limited electrical hook-ups are available by RESERVATION & ADVANCED PAYMENT ONLY. Electric is not guaranteed & you will need at least 100-150 feet of cords.

The RV parking locations will be numbered and assigned as your reservations are made. There will be NO UNRESERVED PARKING in this area. Cones may not be used to secure more space or to save areas for friends, handlers, etc. Groups wishing to park next to each other MUST send reservations in the same envelope

Access to this reserved parking lot will start at 12:00 pm Friday, September 11, 2009 until after Best in Show judging on Sunday, September 13, 2009. There are no water hook-ups or sewer hook-ups at the reservation only site. A sanitary dump is located at the regular campsites. Each exhibitor is responsible for keeping their assigned area clean during his stay. Please read premium for additional information and regulations.

Fees for overnight reserved RV parking is \$30.00 per night or \$50.00 for two nights. Reservations will be taken any time but will close when limit (15) is reached. Reservation fees are non-refundable. A card (or e-mail, if address provided) confirming your reservation will be sent with your assigned parking number.

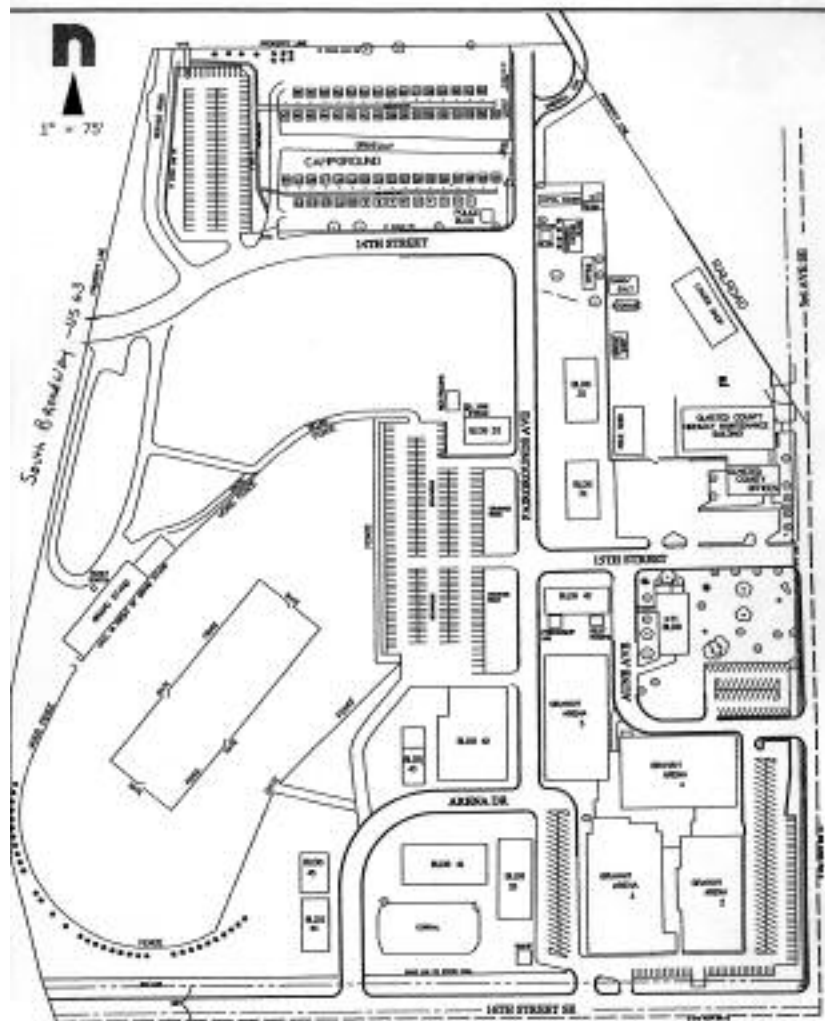

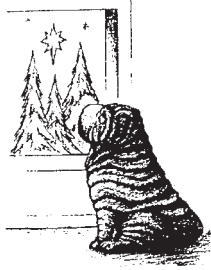
